US Exec Meets with Successful Chinese Rescue Team

New York, June 19, 2008 - During a visit last week to the Peoples Republic of China to review the performance of the firm's LifeLocator® Search and Rescue System, UltraVision Vice-President Bill Lozon met with several regional rescue teams from Chengdu, Chongqing, Beijing, the China International Search and Rescue Squad and the Hebei Fire Brigade.

While speaking with Zhao Jie, a leader of a team from the Hebei Fire Brigade that traveled to the Sichuan region in the days immediately following the May 12th 8.0 earthquake, Mr. Lozon and Pei Zhang of Ancom, UVSS's distributor in China, learned that late in the day May 14th, the Team found 50 year old Xianying Huang buried in the rubble of her collapsed 6 story apartment building located in Nanba Village, Pingwu County. Ms. Huang was buried under approximately 3-4 meters (10-15 feet) of concrete and other debris for almost 57 hours before being detected by the UVSS LifeLocator. Though completely covered and immobile, LifeLocator detected the minute motion of Ms. Huang's breathing and alerted rescuers that life was detected under the tons of debris. Ms. Huang, who ultimately sustained only a minor foot injury, was pulled free after several hours to the cheers of the rescuers involved in the difficult and dangerous rescue work. Team Leader Jie went on to say that LifeLocator was also successful in the rescue of another woman two days later in the same area who was buried for over 70 hours.

Fire officials from the Chongqing Fire Brigade, the Beijing Rescue Squad, and Hongbo Si, Manager of the China International Search and Rescue Organization (CISAR) all of which played a role in the rescue effort also lauded LifeLocator's ability to save valuable time by identifying search areas where no living trapped victims were detected thereby allowing rescuers to focus efforts on other areas while reducing risk of injury of the rescuers themselves.
